# JOIN NOW!

Membership is open to college, university, and K-12 educators, administrators and students involved in international education. PaCIE offers two different types of membership—**institutional** and **individual membership** on a sliding scale.

### Basic institutional membership \$100

Join as an institution and five people from the organization receive discounted conference registration fees, the PaCIE newsletter and other future publications, and are eligible to serve on PaCIE committees and the Board.

### Sponsoring institutional membership \$250

Up to 12 people within the organization can receive discounted conference registration fees, the PaCIE newsletter and other future publications, and are eligible to serve on PaCIE committees and the Board. In addition, the organization will receive prominent mention in the PaCIE annual conference program and on the Web site as a sponsoring member.

### Individual membership Based on income

Individual members receive discounted conference registration fee, the newsletter and other future publications, and are eligible to serve on a PaCIE committee or the Board.

### The sliding scale for individual membership is:

Student or income below \$25,000	<b>\$20</b>
\$25,000-\$44,999 income	<b>\$35</b>
\$45,000 and above	<b>\$50</b>

- PaCIE has carried out a wide range of projects and programs. It
- founded the Pennsylvania Governor's School in International Education
- awarded Penn PaCIE grants to a variety of colleges and universities to advance international education and to support collaborative projects. Membership was later extended to K-12 teachers and schools.
